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Introduction

This paper is about learning to trust God's faithfulness during seasons of waiting. Often, we ask God to change our circumstances, but He is faithfully using those seasons to transform our hearts, strengthen our faith, and draw us closer to Jesus Christ. This paper was born out of one of the longest lessons God has been teaching me—learning to trust Him while I wait.

Throughout my life, I have waited for healing, restoration, answered prayers, and a clearer understanding of His plans.

At times, the waiting felt overwhelming, and I wondered why God seemed silent when I longed for Him to move.

Looking back now, I realize my waiting was never wasted. While I was asking God to change my circumstances, He was patiently changing me. He taught me to depend on His character instead of my feelings, to trust His promises instead of my own understanding, and to discover that His presence is often His greatest gift.

There are seasons in every believer's life when waiting becomes one of the greatest tests of faith. We wait for healing, restored relationships, lighter grief, open doors, and answered prayers. As days become months become years, it is easy to become discouraged and wonder if God is still working.

Scripture is filled with people who understood the pain of waiting. Abraham waited for God's promised son. Joseph waited through betrayal, slavery, and imprisonment. David waited years between being anointed king and sitting on Israel's throne. Yet in each story, waiting did not mean God was absent. It became the place where He accomplished His deepest work.

The same is true today. God often does His greatest work in us while we are waiting for Him to work around us. Waiting is rarely easy, but when it is placed in God's hands, it is never meaningless.





Learning to Trust God in the Waiting

Waiting has been one of the greatest themes of my life. Looking back, I realize that much of my journey has been marked by waiting—for healing, restoration, direction, changed relationships, lighter grief, and answers to prayers I carried for many years.

There were times when I watched others move forward while I felt stuck in the same place. If I am honest, there were moments when I wondered if God had forgotten me. Before I came to know Jesus Christ as my Savior, I had no foundation for understanding God's purposes. The wounds of my childhood, along with experiences of abuse, rejection, and disappointment, left me searching for acceptance and significance in places that could never satisfy my heart.

When I surrendered my life to Jesus Christ at the age of thirty-three, I expected many struggles to disappear quickly. Instead, God invited me into a lifelong journey of trusting Him. Some prayers were answered immediately, while others required years of waiting. During those years, I often asked God to change my circumstances, but He was quietly changing me.

Through His Word, prayer, and the work of the Holy Spirit, He began healing the wounds that had shaped my life. He taught me that my identity is found in Christ, my worth comes from being His child, and His love does not depend on my performance or the approval of others.

Today, I still experience waiting seasons, but I no longer see waiting as wasted time. I have learned that God is present even when He seems silent, and He is working even when I cannot see what He is doing. Every delay has become an opportunity to trust Him more deeply, surrender my plans more fully, and rest in the truth that His timing is always perfect.

God has used every season to strengthen my faith, deepen my dependence on His grace, and draw me closer to Jesus. Looking back, I can honestly say that the greatest gift was not simply receiving the answers I desired but knowing Him more deeply through the waiting.

His faithfulness has become the anchor of my life, and it is that same faithfulness I long for others to experience.



What God's Word Teaches About Waiting

Throughout Scripture, waiting has always been part of God's work in the lives of His people. Waiting is not God's way of ignoring us or withholding His love.

More often, it is one of His greatest tools for strengthening our faith, shaping our character, and teaching us to depend completely on Him.

Abraham waited many years before God fulfilled His promise of a son. Joseph waited through betrayal, slavery, and imprisonment before seeing God's purpose unfold. David waited years between being anointed king and sitting on Israel's throne. Hannah waited for the child she longed for, and even the disciples waited for the Holy Spirit before beginning the ministry Christ had prepared for them. In each story, God was faithfully working long before His people could see it.

One of the greatest truths I have learned is that God's silence never means His absence. There are seasons when He appears quiet, yet He is accomplishing His deepest work beneath the surface. While we are asking Him to change our circumstances, He is often transforming our hearts. He teaches perseverance through trials, humility through dependence, patience through delay, and deeper trust through uncertainty.

Waiting also reveals where our hope truly rests. If our hope is only in receiving the answer we desire, discouragement can overtake us. But when our hope is anchored in God's unchanging character, we discover peace that does not depend on our circumstances.

His love remains constant, His promises remain true, and His timing remains perfect. The greatest blessing of waiting is not simply that God eventually answers our prayers. The greatest blessing is that we come to know Him more intimately. God never wastes a season of waiting.

Every prayer, tear, disappointment, and moment of trust becomes part of His work of making us more like Jesus Christ. When we place our lives in His hands, we can rest in the assurance that His plans are good, His purposes are perfect, and His faithfulness endures forever.



Living This Truth

Learning to trust God while we wait is not something we accomplish in a single day.

It is a choice we make every morning as we surrender our plans, our fears, and our unanswered questions to Him. Some days that choice comes easily. Other days it requires us to cling to His promises when our emotions tell us to give up. Yet it is in those moments of surrender that our faith grows stronger.

I have learned that waiting does not have to be wasted time. Instead of allowing discouragement to consume us, we can use these seasons to draw closer to the Lord. Time spent in His Word, honest conversations through prayer, and quiet moments of worship remind us that our greatest need is not simply an answer to prayer but a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ.

As we seek Him first, He changes our perspective even before He changes our circumstances.

Living this truth also means choosing gratitude over bitterness and hope over despair. It means remembering God's past faithfulness when the future feels uncertain. I often find myself looking back over my own journey and seeing countless ways God carried me through situations that once seemed impossible. Remembering His faithfulness gives me confidence that He will continue to be faithful in whatever lies ahead.

you are in a season of waiting today, I encourage you not to measure God's love by how quickly your circumstances change. Measure it by the cross of Jesus Christ, where He demonstrated His unfailing love finally. Trust that He sees every tear, hears every prayer, and understands every burden you carry.

Continue seeking Him, continue obeying His Word, and continue believing that His timing is always perfect.

Although you may not understand what God is doing today, one day you may look back and discover that the season you once wanted to escape became one of the greatest seasons of spiritual growth in your life. The waiting was never meant to destroy your faith. In God's hands, it becomes the very place where your faith is strengthened, your character is refined, and your hope is anchored more firmly in Him.

As you continue walking with Christ one step at a time, you will discover that the God who has faithfully carried you this far will never stop walking beside you.



How This Truth Has Shaped My Ministry Calling

One of the greatest ways God has prepared me for ministry has been through seasons of waiting.

Looking back over my life, I can see that the waiting was never simply about delayed answers to prayer. It was God's classroom, where He patiently taught me to trust His heart even when I could not understand His timing.

Through every season of uncertainty, He was shaping my character, deepening my faith, and preparing me to walk alongside others who would one day face similar struggles.

Because I have experienced the pain of waiting, I understand what it feels like to wonder if God has forgotten you. I know what it is like to pray for healing, restoration, direction, and answers while the days stretch into months and the months into years. Those experiences have given me a compassion that could never have been learned from a classroom alone. They have taught me to listen with grace, encourage with Scripture, and remind others that God's faithfulness is not measured by how quickly He answers our prayers but by the certainty that He never abandons His children.

Today, God has called me to minister to broken, hurting, and spiritually weary people by pointing them to the hope found in Jesus Christ. Through writing, teaching, discipleship, and sharing my testimony, my desire is to encourage others to trust God through life's waiting seasons.
