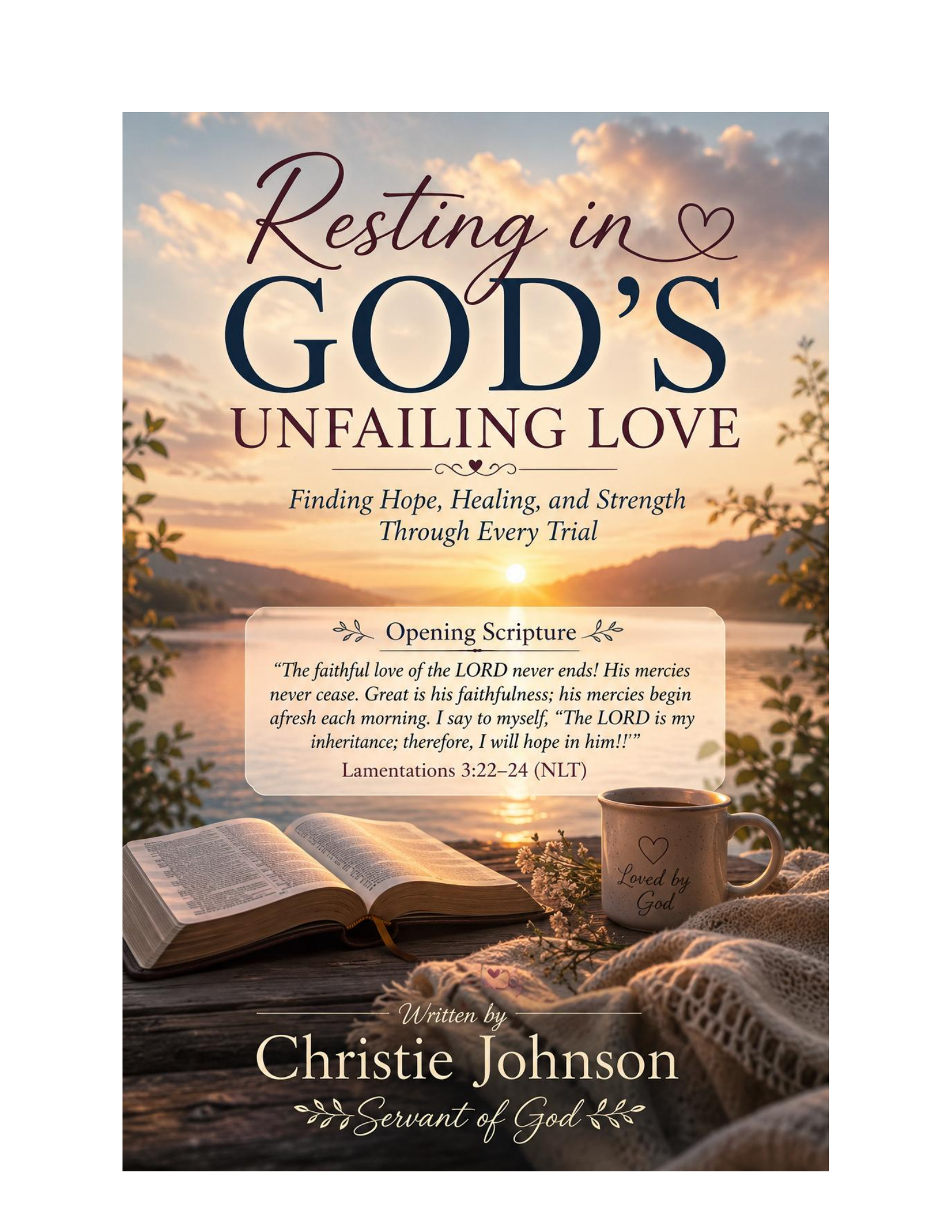

Throughout my Christian walk, one of the greatest truths God has taught me is that His love never changes, even when everything around me does. During those times, I often measured my value by the acceptance of people rather than by the truth of God's Word.

My Journey of Learning to Rest in God's Unfailing Love

One of the greatest lessons God has taught me is that His love remains constant, even when my emotions, circumstances, and relationships are not. For many years, love had to be earned. I measured my value by how others responded to me, and when I experienced rejection, criticism, or disappointment, I questioned my worth and whether I was absolutely loved.

Although I had placed my faith in Jesus Christ, painful experiences often spoke louder than God's promises. Old wounds resurfaced, and I carried burdens that Christ had already invited me to surrender. Instead of resting in His love, I tried to carry life's hurts in my own strength.

As my faith grew, God patiently changed the way I viewed Him. I realized His love is not like human love. It is not based on my performance, successes, or failures but on His unchanging character. Even when I struggled with doubt or discouragement, He never stopped pursuing me with grace and compassion. God also taught me that spiritual growth is not about never failing but about continually returning to Him.

Rather than condemning me, He lovingly convicted me, led me to repentance, and reminded me that His grace was sufficient.

Instead of seeing failure as proof that I was not enough, I began seeing it as another opportunity to experience God's mercy. His love never pushed me away—it continually drew me closer.

Today, I still face difficult days, and old thoughts sometimes try to return. Yet I have learned that God's truth is greater than my feelings, His promises are stronger than my fears, and His love remains steadfast regardless of my circumstances. Resting in His love is not passive; it is a daily choice to trust His faithfulness above everything else.

Looking back, I can now see that every trial became an opportunity for God to reveal His character. Through every season, He has shown Himself to be compassionate, patient, faithful, and unchanging. While my circumstances have often changed, His love never has.

That truth has become one of the greatest sources of hope, peace, and strength in my walk with Jesus Christ.



What God's Word Teaches About God's Unfailing Love

One of the greatest truths in Scripture is that God's love never changes because God Himself never changes. Unlike human love, which is often affected by emotions or circumstances, God's love is perfect, faithful, and eternal because it flows from His holy character.

Because God's love is secure, we can approach Him with confidence rather than fear. When we fail, He forgives, restores, and continues transforming us into the likeness of Christ. His discipline is never rooted in rejection but in His desire to help us grow.

Understanding God's unfailing love changes how we live. Instead of striving to earn His acceptance, we rest in what Christ has already secured. We are motivated by gratitude, and the Holy Spirit renews our hearts and teaches us to love others with the same mercy God has shown us.

The more we understand God's love, the more we trust His faithfulness. His promises become our anchor, His presence becomes our peace, and His grace becomes our strength. God's unfailing love is the firm foundation upon which the Christian life is built.



Living in God's Unfailing Love Every Day

Knowing that God loves us is one thing; learning to live in that love each day is another. Many believers understand that God loves them but struggle to believe His love is enough when life becomes difficult. The pressures of life, painful memories, and the opinions of others can distract us from the truth of God's Word. That is why we must continually return to Him and allow His truth to shape our hearts and minds.

I have learned that peace does not come from a life free of trials but from trusting God's unchanging character and believing His love remains constant.

Living in God's love changes how we respond to life's challenges. Instead of allowing rejection to harden our hearts, we extend forgiveness because Christ has forgiven us. Instead of allowing disappointment to steal our hope, we trust that God is still working for our good and His glory.

Rather than carrying every burden ourselves, we surrender them to the Lord, knowing He cares for us.

This kind of life comes from intentionally abiding in Christ. As we spend time in God's Word, pray, worship, and remain connected to other believers, the Holy Spirit renews our minds, strengthens our faith, and transforms us to become more like Jesus.

One of the greatest changes God has made in my life is teaching me to stop seeking the approval of others and begin resting in His approval. Although I still face struggles, I now know where to turn. God's Word reminds me who He is, who I am in Christ, and that His love has never failed me.

Resting in God's unfailing love does not mean life will always be easy. It means that whatever tomorrow brings, we can face it with confidence because God is faithful, His promises are true, and His presence will never leave us. That assurance has become one of the greatest sources of peace in my own life and is a gift He offers to everyone who chooses to trust Him.



How This Truth Shaped My Ministry Calling

As I reflect on my journey, I see that God's greatest work was not simply bringing me through difficult circumstances—it was teaching me to trust His heart. Through seasons of rejection, grief, disappointment, and uncertainty, God showed me that His love never depended on my performance, the approval of others, or my circumstances. His love remained constant because He is constant.

This truth has become one foundation of the ministry God has called me to. Every person carries a story, and many struggle with shame, grief, fear, rejection, or disappointment. Many know about God's love but struggle to believe it is personal. I understand that struggle because I have walked that road myself.

God has placed a deep desire in my heart to help people experience His unfailing love through biblical teaching, discipleship, testimony, and spiritual formation. My prayer is to help others trust God's promises, rest in His love, and grow into who He created them to be. Lasting transformation comes from abiding in Christ and allowing the Holy Spirit to change us from the inside out.
